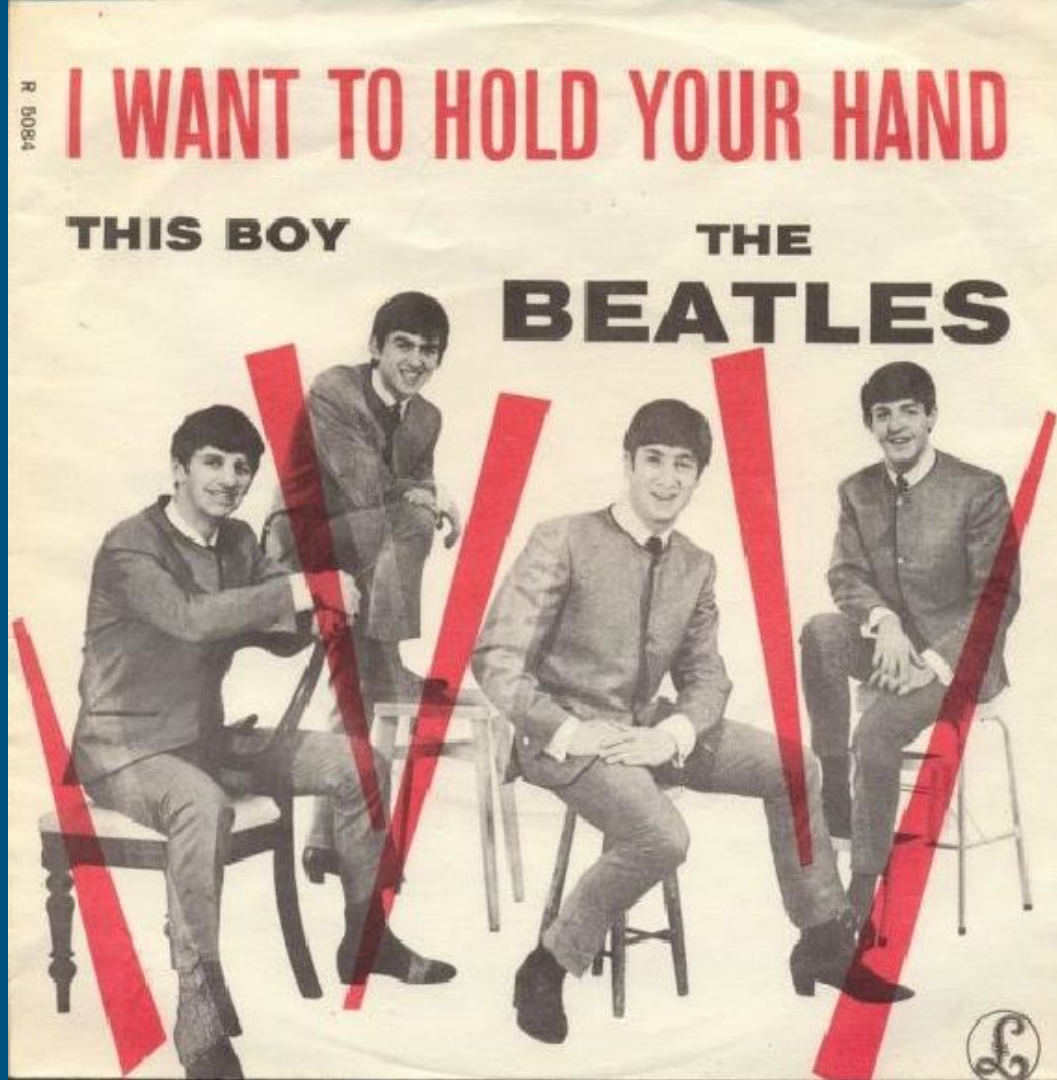

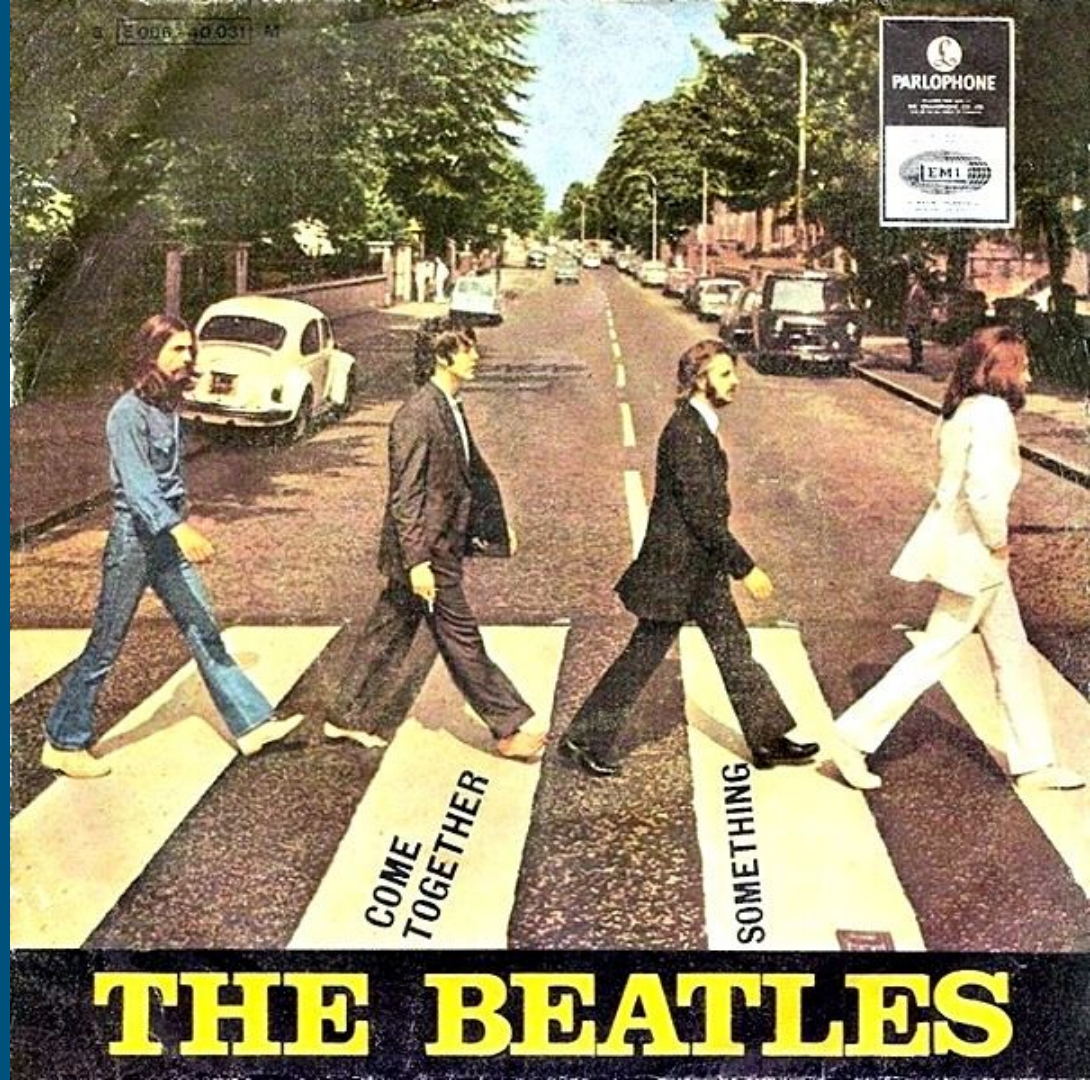

- Systems of exclusion within major indexing services have deleterious effects on institutional rankings, particularly for those with less of a STEM focus
