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## PROGRAM GOALS

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- **Primary:** To enrich participants' experiences with the LPC, and build relationships between peers.
  - **Secondary:** To further the development of library publishing through a professional, semi-structured mentorship program.
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## MENTORSHIP ACTIVITIES

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- **Virtual:** Initial getting-to-know-you phone call; once-per-month meetings over phone.
  - **In-Person:** We will have an event or meetup planned for the Library Publishing Forum.
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## ELIGIBILITY AND APPLYING

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- All LPC members are welcome to apply (you do not need to be a voting member).
  - Apply via a Google Form asking basic contact and professional information, plus a questionnaire with goals and expectations for your peer mentorship experience.
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## GUIDELINES

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- We will provide a list of basic guidelines for peers to adhere to (establish ground rules, meeting schedule, be open and positive, etc.) and a basic Code of Conduct. How you maintain your relationship is up to you!
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## TIMELINE

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- The first cohort will participate from January 2020-December 2020. There will be a mid-year check-in at the Forum and an evaluation questionnaire at the end of the cycle.
  - The mid-year check-in will include a survey to assess the effectiveness of the peer-mentor relationship, and necessary changes to program participation can be made at that point.
  - Each year, we will open up applications for new peer mentorship matches, alumni are welcome to apply for a new peer mentor!
