• We will provide a list of basic guidelines for pairs to adhere to (establish ground rules, meeting schedule, be open and positive, etc.) and a basic Code of Conduct.

TIMELINE

- The 2022 Program will run from February 2022 to December 2022. There will be a midyear check-in survey in the summer and an evaluation questionnaire in December.
- The mid-year check-in provides an opportunity for necessary changes to program participation.
- Each year, we will open up applications for new participants. Alumni are welcome!
